## **Financial Implications**

#### How much does it cost?

I think we should reckon that the total cost of the trip and all that is associated with it is **£2500**.

We would go with a minimum of eight

However, the larger the group is the more comfortable the finances become and the cost could come down to approx. £2300.

# What does this pay for?

- All international air fares
- Hotel and accommodation costs on the basis of full board
- All meals on trek
- All internal transportation
- All facilities on trek and trekking crew
- Insurance
- Airport taxes
- Transport to and from UK airport
- All training expenses

# What does it not pay for?

- Personal kit bought prior to departure. (We have a discount deal with Cotswold Outdoor and they will hold a kit evening in store where you can receive expert advice)
- Personal expenses on the trip phone calls, laundry, bar bills etc.

# When do you pay?

### There will be four payments of £500 and one final balance payment

- Registration and first payment by Friday 27<sup>th</sup> March 2015
- Second payment due on or before 30th June 2015
- Third payment due on or before **31st Oct. 2015**
- Fourth payment due on or before **31st Jan. 2016**
- Fifth and final balance payment due on or before 22<sup>nd</sup> April 2016

All cheques should be made payable to King's School Worcester and sent Josh Hand C/o King's School

It may be that some of the costs could be reduced through fundraising but this is very dependent upon the enthusiasm of the team and the amount of support they can generate. However, the costs as indicated, do not take fundraising into consideration.

### Health

There are no specific vaccination requirements for entry to Kyrgyzstan but you might want to make sure that all the childhood vaccinations are up to date.
