- This itinerary allows us to visit and experience 16 schools and 5 health posts.
- It will be necessary to have the support of Rajendra and Rati from REED and somebody from AFNepal accompanying the trek.
- Accommodation will be in lodges or camping, whichever is preferred. Appropriate number of tents will be purchased on arrival in Kathmandu and will thereafter be available for trustee/volunteer use.
- All food will be taken in lodges.
- Porters will be employed locally to carry kit and tents.
- The emphasis of our input will be largely in support of the teachers with English, maths and science. Any English conversation with teachers will be vital if they are to improve their own standard.
- It is hoped that by having several sets of eyes looking at the schools, the group would automatically become an advisory body, looking at how the

educational provision within the schools can be improved and how best to resource it.

- Those with health expertise will decide what the emphasis should be with regard to health.
- Importantly, because we will be largely self sufficient, the cost for this 31 day trip would be in the region of £1000 £1200 + international flights.
- International flights cost in the region of £450 £500. Good services are provided from Heathrow with Etihad, Jet Airways and Qatar.
