


# Hiking in the High Tatras

**Dates: Fri. 21st - Fri. 28th Sept. 2018**



## Highlights

- The best of the High Tatras – from east to west
- Highest peak of Poland – Rysy (2499 m)
- Slovak Paradise - hiking through gorges and waterfalls
- Easy day – get familiar with local life and rich history below the Tatras

## Day by day:

### **Day 1: Arrival to the High Tatras**

Meeting in Krakow (or Poprad), arrival to the Tatras through the picturesque Polish highlands – “Podhale”

### **Day 2: Between the High Tatras and White Tatras**

“Warm up” hiking to the pass of Kopske sedlo (1.725 m), White and Green glacial lakes

### **Day 3: In the shade of the highest peak of the Carpathians**

Ascent of Vychodna Vysoka peak (2.429 m) - great viewpoint - neighbor of Gerlach peak (2.655 m)

### **Day 4: Hiking to Tery hut - a traditional mountain hut in the High Tatras**

Ascent of the valley Mala Studena dolina to the Tery hut (2.015 m)

### **Day 5: Easy day - Dunajec river raft trip**

Rafting tour through the Dunajec river gorge on wooden rafts

### **Day 6: Slovak Paradise – Sucha Bela gorge**

Hiking along mountain streams and waterfalls, trail secured by wooden and iron vertical ladders

### **Day 7: The highest peak of Poland – Rysy**

Ascent of Mt. Rysy (2.499 m) – great view of both sides of Tatras (Polish and Slovak one)

### **Day 8: Departure for Krakow/Poprad**

En route to Krakow review your hiking tour on panoramic drive around the Tatras
