

Altai Trek

Day 1: 7th July - Depart UK at 09.20 on Flight OS73781 from Manchester

Day 2: 8th July – Arrive Ulaan Baatar at 10.50 on Flight CA901 from Beijing. Upon your arrival in Ulaan Baatar, you will be met by our representatives, and after checking in at your hotel, we will take you on a city sightseeing tour. (Bayangol Hotel)

Day 3: 9th July - Fly to Ulgii You will fly to Ulgii City, in the Bayan-Ulgii province of Western Mongolia. At the local airport, you'll meet your English-speaking guide, driver and expedition cook. Today we'll drive to one of the local area Nadam Festival. 80 km (Tent/L/D).

Day 4: 10th July – Drive to Khoton and Khurgan lake

Today we'll drive to Khoton and Khurgan Lake, stopping for lunch on the way, and we will see the ancient Deer Stones and Balbal Stones, 6th to 8th century Turkish burial markers. 100 km (Tent/L/D).



Day 5-6: 11th & 12th July - Horse ride to the Baga turgen waterfall. One of these days we'll visit to the Kazkah Eagle hunter family. There will be plenty to see and do. Explore the real way of living of regular nomadic family. To personally experience their friendliness and hospitality. The Eagle hunters will show us their training methods and you will be introduced to the art of eagle hunting and can talk with the hunters (Through an interpreter) about how he trains and hunts with his eagle. The tradition of hunting with Eagles goes back thousands of years in central Asia. Camel support. (Tent/B/L/D)



Day 7: 13th July – Aral Tolgoi- Bear valley- Camel support. (Tent/B/L/D)

Day 8: 14th July - Bear valley – Takhilt to cross the highest pass. Camel support (Tent/B/L/D)

Day 9: 15th July – Takhilt -Khar salaa. Camel support. (Tent/B/L/D)

Day 10: 16th July - Khar salaa -Shiveet mountain. Camel support, (Tent/B/L/D)

Day 11: 17th July - Hike to Shiveet Uul Mountain, with its stunningly beautiful blue lakes, 4000 m high snow-capped mountains, a glacier and rich for archaeological sites. Camel support (Tent/B/L/D)



Day 12: 18th July - Shiveet Uul Mountain - Tsagaan gol Valley Today we will hike to the Tsagaan gol Valley. Camel support (Tent/B/L/D)

Day 13: 19th July – July Hiking to the Tavan Bogd Base Camp Today we will hike 6 hours to the base camp of Tavan Bogd. Our luggage will be transported by camels, handled by the local people, they are friendly and helpful. On the way you can see the ice peaks of the Potanin and Alexander Glaciers. The base camp is at an elevation of 3500 m. Camel support (Tent/B/L/D)

Day 14: 20th July - Rest Day (Tent/B/L/D)



Day 15: 21st July - Climbing to Malchin Peak After breakfast we will start slowly walking for about an hour and then start climbing to Malchin Peak (4050 m), which is on the Mongolian side of the Russian border. Malchin Peak is the lowest of the Holy Five Peaks. It takes 6 to 7 hours to climb to the top of Malchin. Most of the climb will be on rocks, then back to camp to relax. (Tent/B/L/D)

Day 16: 22nd July-Today we'll hike back to Oigor Gol Valley. The total trip will take about about 5-6 hours. (Tent/L/D).

Day 17: 23rd July - Drive back to Ulgii Today we'll drive back to Ulgii. Afternoon do some arts and crafts shopping. Overnight you can stay at Eagle's Nest, and take a good hot shower. (Hotel/B/L/D)

Day 18: 24th July - Return flight to Ulaan Baatar, On arrival, transfer to your hotel. (Hotel/B/L/D)

Day 19: 25th July – Day in Ulaan Baatar. Farewell dinner (Hotel/B/L/D)

Day 20: 26th July – Transfer to the airport and depart for the journey home at 11.50 on Flight CA902 for Beijing (B)

Day 21: 27th July – Arrive Manchester on Flight OS7371 at 10.30
